## At the Vigil Mass

### ENTRANCE ANTIPHON

#### ROMAN MISSAL, VIGIL

Glorious things are spoken of you, O Mary,  
who today were exalted above the choirs of Angels  
into eternal triumph with Christ.

#### ROMAN GRADUAL, VIGIL, Ps 44: 13,15,16,2

##### *Vultum Tuum*

All the rich among the people will implore your countenance.  
Virgins will be brought to the king in her retinue; her  
companions will be taken to you in gladness and rejoicing.

✠ My heart overflows with a goodly theme; I address my works to the king

## At Mass during the Day

### ENTRANCE ANTIPHON Rev 12:1, Ps 98

#### *Signum Magnum*

A great sign appeared in heaven:  
a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon beneath her feet,  
and on her head a crown of twelve stars.

✠ Sing unto the Lord a new song, for he has  
accomplished wondrous deeds.

Or:

*Gaudeamus omnes in Domino, Ps 44*

Let us all rejoice in the Lord,  
as we celebrate the feast day in honor of the Virgin Mary,  
at whose Assumption the Angels rejoice  
and praise the Son of God.

✠ My heart overflows with a goodly theme; I address my works to the king

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Both the Missal and the Gradual list these exact same two introts for the Mass during the Day. The Gradual adds the ✠.

# Introit Hymn OPTION 1

## Both vigil and day

1. Hail, Holy Queen enthroned above, O Maria!  
Hail, Queen of mercy and of love, O Maria!  
Triumph, all ye cherubim,  
Sing with us, ye seraphim!  
Heav'n and earth resound the hymn:  
Salve, Salve, Salve, Regina!

2. Of thee are spoken glorious things, O Maria!  
Exalted high with Christ our King, O Maria!  
Over all the cherubim,  
Raised above the seraphim!  
Sing we your triumphant hymn:  
Salve, Salve, Salve, Regina!

3. In heav'n a glorious sign appeared, O Maria!  
Clothed with the sun, a maid revered, O Maria!  
And the moon beneath her feet,  
In her crown the twelve stars meet, (ALTERED: With twelve stars her crown replete,)  
Our new song we shall repeat:  
Salve, Salve, Salve, Regina!

# Introit Hymn OPTION 2

## Second antiphon for DAY AND VIGIL (NEW)

1a. (Vigil) Glorious things of thee are spoken,  
Mary, clothed in gold attire,  
Who today has been exalted  
Over every angel choir;  
Into triumph you have entered  
Now with Christ eternally;  
Mother, at your great assumption,  
Glorious things are said of thee.

1b.(Day) Let us all rejoice in God and  
celebrate this festive day,  
Honoring the Virgin Mary,  
Clothed on high in bright array.  
Glorious is her great Assumption,  
Angels shout their praise and sing  
to the Son of God and Mary,  
Holy Mother of the King.

## Use with Hail, Holy Queen

How can you NOT sing the original first verse? Catholics sing it better than any other song.

Verse 2 is the Vigil antiphon (Missal)

Verse 3 is the Day antiphon
