Introit Hymn OPTION 1 LM with Alleluias!

Ant. Let us rejoice and celebrate
this feast in honor of all saints, alleluia, alleluia!
Angels, at this solemnity,
sing praise, O Son of God, to Thee,
O praise him, O praise him,
alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!

Use only with LASST UNS ERFREUEN:
(All Creatures of Our God and King)

Vs. Ring out your joy to God and sing;
You just and upright, praises bring, alleluia, alleluia!
With harp and lute, we thank the Lord;
Sing a new song, with praise outpoured,
O praise him, O praise him,
alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!

Dox. Let all things their Creator bless,
and worship him in humbleness,
O praise him, alleluia!
Praise, praise the Father, praise the Son,
and praise the Spirit, three in one,
O praise him, O praise him,
alleluia, alleluia, alleluia!

Ant. We rejoice and celebrate Alleluia!
this great feast for all the saints; Alleluia!
Angels, this solemnity, Alleluia!
sing their praise, O God, to Thee. Alleluia!

Vs. Ring out joy to God and sing; Alleluia!
All you upright, praises bring. Alleluia!
With a new song, praise the Lord, Alleluia!
give him thanks with one accord. Alleluia!

Dox. Sing we to our God above, Alleluia!
praise eternal as his love; Alleluia!
praise him, all ye heav'nly host, Alleluia!
Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Alleluia!

verse 1.

Introit Hymn OPTION 3 LM

Ant. Let us rejoice and celebrate
this feast in honor of all saints.
Angels, at this solemnity,
Sing praise, O Son of God, to Thee.

Vs. Ring out your joy to God and sing;
You just and upright, praises bring.
With harp and lute, we thank the Lord;
sing a new song, with praise outpoured.

Dox. Praise God, from whom all blessings flow;
Praise him, all creatures here below;
Praise him all saints and heav'nly host,
Praise Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

Tune: OLD HUNDRETH, Thomas Ken

Pick one tune for Introit Hymn option 3, LM:

Blessings Flow*
O WALY WALY: The Gift of Love
DUKE STREET: I Know That My Redeemer Lives

appointed Psalm 33 as verse 2.

← you can use this doxology based on OLD
HUNDRETH as verse 3, and then return to the
antiphon as verse 4.

Introit Hymn OPTION 4

Ant. Let us rejoice in God and celebrate
This solemn feast, All Saints we venerate;
The Son of God all angels adulate:
Alleluia, Alleluia!

Use with SINE NOMINE only: *For All the Saints*

Vs. Rejoice and sing you righteous in the Lord,
Praise from the upright fittingly accord;
Give thanks and sing for clemency outpoured:
Alleluia, Alleluia!

← you can use this verse from the appointed Psalm 33 as verse 2.

Dox. Praise we the Father, praise we now the Son,
And Holy Spirit, Blessed Three in One;
Who with All Saints praise God for vict'ry won:
Alleluia, Alleluia!

← you can use this doxology as verse 3, then return to antiphon as verse 1.
