

SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Is 48: 20*

Vocem iucunditatis annuntiate

Roman Missal: Proclaim a joyful sound and let it be heard;
proclaim to the ends of the earth:
The Lord has freed his people, alleluia.

Roman Gradual: Spread the news with a voice of joy ; let it be heard, alleluia;
speak it out to the very ends of the earth; the Lord has liberated
his people, alleluia, alleluia.

✠ Shout joyfully to God all the earth;
sing a psalm to his name; praise him with magnificence.

These antiphons
basically match, but the
Gradual includes extra
alleluias and a verse.
