

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

Both the Roman Gradual and Roman Missal offer these same two antiphons.

1. ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Ps 27 (26): 8-9*

Tibi dixit cor meum

Of you my heart has spoken, Seek his face.
It is your face, O Lord, that I seek;
hide not your face from me.

∿ The Lord is my light and my salvation;
whom shall I fear?

Or: Cf. Ps 25 (24): 6, 2, 22

Reminiscere

2. Remember your compassion, O Lord,
and your merciful love, for they are from of old.
Let not our enemies exult over us.
Redeem us, O God of Israel, from all our distress.

∿ To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul.
In you, O my God, I have trusted;
