ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Ps 139 (138): 18, 5-6*

Resurrexi, et adhuc tecum sum, alleluia:

I have risen, and I am with you still, alleluia.

You have laid your hand upon me, alleluia.

Too wonderful for me, this knowledge, alleluia, alleluia.

Ÿ O Lord, you have searched me and known me;

You know when I sit down and rise up.

← The verse in Roman Gradual, Ps. 139.

The Roman Gradual only has one antiphon. The Roman Missal adds one more option, below.

Or: Lk 24: 34; cf. Rev 1: 6

Surrexit Dominus vere, alleluia. Ipsi gloria et imperium per universa aeternitatis saecula, alleluia, alleluia.

The Lord is truly risen, alleluia.

To him be glory and power

for all the ages of eternity, alleluia, alleluia.
