Introit Hymn OPTION 1 888 with Alleluias

Ant. The Lord is my salvation, light,
Of whom shall my own heart take fright?
Those who do evil cannot fight,
Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

✠ Though a large host encamp 'round me,
Never my heart will fear, nor flee,
I will be confident in Thee,
Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

Dox. Praise God The Father, God the Son,
And God the Spirit, Three in One;
Our Triune God while ages run,
Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia

Use with Gelobt Sei Gott: *Good Christians All, Rejoice and Sing/O Sons and Daughters of the King.*

Could use with "The Strife is O'er" if triple Alleluias are put at the beginning and one Alleluia added to end.

Return to the Antiphon as verse 4 if time permits.
