### 1. ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Ps 27 (26): 8-9*

Tibi dixit cor meum

Of you my heart has spoken, Seek his face.  
It is your face, O Lord, that I seek;  
hide not your face from me.

☩ The Lord is my light and my salvation;  
whom shall I fear?

*Or: Cf. Ps 25 (24): 6, 2, 22*

Reminiscere

2. Remember your compassion, O Lord,  
and your merciful love, for they are from of old.  
Let not our enemies exult over us.  
Redeem us, O God of Israel, from all our distress.

☩ To you, O Lord, I lift up my soul.  
In you, O my God, I have trusted;

### 3. ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Mt 17:5*

In a resplendent cloud the Holy Spirit appeared.  
The Father's voice was heard: This is my beloved Son,  
with whom I am well pleased. Listen to him.

## Introit Hymn OPTION 1

### ALL OPTIONS COMBINED

1. In a resplendent cloud appeared  
The Holy Spirit, and was heard  
The Father's voice "This is my Son,  
listen to my beloved one."

2. My heart declared to you, O God:  
Your loving countenance I've sought;  
I shall your countenance embrace,  
Lord do not turn from me your face.

3. The Lord my light, salvation art;  
No fear encroach my trusting heart.  
Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost.  
In Triune God we make our boast.

*2b. Remember your compassion, Lord,  
Your loving mercy from of old;  
Let not our foes exult o'er us,  
Redeem us, God, from wretchedness.*

In you I trust, fore'er extol.  
Praise Father, Son, and Spirit blest,

The Father's voice was heard while  
Apostles shrank in fear.  
This is my Son beloved,  
With whom I am well pleased.  
O listen to his teachings,  
Unto his words pay heed.

AURELIA: The Church's One Foundation

NON DIGNUS: O Lord, I Am Not Worthy (*split verse  
and repeat antiphon as needed*)

FULDA: O Sacrament Most Holy

O turn it not from me!  
All praise, O God the Father,  
Through Christ, your only Son,  
With the Eternal Spirit,

Hide not from me your face.  
My Lord, salvation, light,  
Of whom shall my heart fear?  
Praise Father, Son and Holy Ghost,  
Our Triune God is near.
