4. O Je - sus, ev - er with us stay!

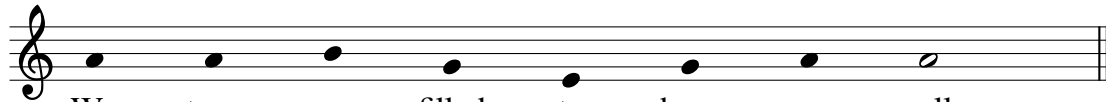
*Introit.* See, I have God to be my help,
