of ev'ryone who seeks him.  
Forever seek his face,  
and in the Lord be strengthened.  
Give thanks unto the Lord;  
Proclaim his wondrous name.  
To nations of the earth  
make known his deeds of fame.

*Dox.* All praise and thanks to God  
the Father now be given,  
the Son and Spirit blest,  
who reign in highest heaven:  
the one eternal God,  
whom heaven and earth adore;  
for thus it was, is now,  
and shall be evermore.

**Use with NUN DANKET:** *Now Thank We All Our God*

← The second half of this antiphon is adapted from vs 1 and 2 of the same psalm, as appointed in the Roman Gradual.

*Ant.* Let the hearts of those rejoice who search unending for the Lord.  
Seek the Lord, and be ye strengthened;  
seek his face for evermore.  
To the Lord give thanks unending,  
ever call upon his name;  
Making known among the nations,  
all his wondrous deeds proclaim.

*Dox.* Glory be to God the Father,  
Glory be to God the Son,  
Glory be to God the Spirit,  
Glory to the Three in One.  
Now with all the saints in heaven  
thanks and praises do we sing;  
Mortals, angels, now for ever  
praise the Lord, our Triune King.

All praise to God the Son,  
All praise to God the Holy Ghost,  
For ever three and one.  
As once it was before, is now,  
and shall be ever more;  
To endless ages he stands firm,  
the God whom we adore.

all praise and glory be;  
As was, is now, and shall be still,  
for all eternity.
