

## 15<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

The Roman Gradual offers 2 options. The Roman Missal includes only the second option.

### 1. ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Ps 54: 17, 18, 19, 20, 23, & 2*

*Dum Clarmarem ad Dominum*

When I cried out to the Lord, he heeded my call against my assailants; he who is before the beginning of the world and who endures forever has humbled them. Cast your cares upon the Lord, and he will sustain you.

✠ Hear my prayer, O God, and despise not my supplication; be attentive to me and hear me.

### 2. ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Ps 17 (16):15*

*Ego autem cum iustitia*

*Roman Missal Translation: As for me, in justice I shall behold your face; I shall be filled with the vision of your glory.*

*Roman Gradual translation: As for me, I will appear before you in righteousness; I will be satisfied when your glory is made manifest.*

I include both translations because each have a setting that adheres more closely to its text.

✠ Give heed, O Lord, to my righteousness; be attentive to my supplication.
