

EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

VIGIL ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Bar 5: 5*

Surge, Ierusalem, et circumspecte ad orientem et vide congregatos filios tuos a solis ortu usque ad occasum.
Arise, Jerusalem, and look to the East
and see your children gathered from the rising to the setting of the sun.

DAY ENTRANCE ANTIPHON *Cf. Mal 3: 1; 1 Chr 29: 12*

Ecce advenit Dominator Dominus;
Behold, the Lord, the Mighty One, has come;
and kingship is in his grasp, and power and dominion.

← The Roman Gradual only has this antiphon. So it may be used at the vigil too, together with psalm 72.

Ÿ Ps. 72: Endow the King with your judgment, O God, and the King's son with your righteousness

See your children great and least,
Gathered from the rising sun
to its setting, all as one.
See, the Mighty Lord has come;
Pow'r, dominion, kingship won.

Use with DIX, 77 77 77: *As With Gladness, Men of Old.*
Consider combining antiphon with this great Epiphany hymn.

2. As foretold, the Lord is come,
Wonder, Couns'lor, Mighty One;
Kingship, pow'r are in his hand,
nations under his command.
Lord, the King with judgment bless,
And his son with righteousness.

←Day, which concludes with the Psalm verse as appointed.

3. Father be all glory giv'n,
You who reign in highest heav'n;
And to Christ concordantly,
At your great Epiphany.
With the Spirit we adore;
Three in One, praise evermore.
