ENTRANCE ANTIPHON Cf. *Ps 27 (26): 7, 9, 1*

Exaudi, Domine, vocem meam, qua clamavi ad te.

Roman Missal Translation: O Lord, hear my voice, for I have called to you; be my help. Do not abandon or forsake me, O God, my Savior!

Roman Gradual Translation: Hearken, O Lord, unto my voice which has called out to you; deign to be my help, forsake me not, do not despise me, O God my Savior.
